
EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

This position entails working directly with children and families within the PACE Family Program. Additional work within the Outreach Support Services to childcare centres may be added.

Within the **Family Program**, the work includes participation in the planning and implementation of a therapeutic play-based preschool program and sharing in either driving or supporting the children to and from the program in our 15 seat passenger van, in partnership with another trained staff member.

The **Outreach Support Services** component includes offering hands-on support and consultation to early childhood and school age programs, supporting children with high emotional and behavioural challenges.
