The successful individuals will have a Class 4 License (or able to obtain) with a minimum 5 year clean driving record and at least 5 years of experience working with preschool-aged children.

The Family Program is a unique, innovative program, with a high ratio of teachers to children, offering a supportive environment to work intensively with both the child and their family, developing social/emotional skills and attachments. The program works in partnership with the child's family, caregivers, and other professionals, to establish goals and a plan based on strengths and needs. This position includes supporting the children to and from the program in our 15-seat passenger van, with another team member.

Outreach Support Services includes offering hands-on support and consultation to early childhood and school age programs, in Vancouver and Richmond, supporting children with high emotional and behavioural challenges.
